IDA PUBLIC SCHOOLS PROCESS FOR CONDUCTING CLASSROOM OBSERVATIONS

- 1. Evaluators will conduct at least 3 observations per school year for each employee (one per marking period preferred)
- 2. One observation will be unscheduled
- 3. Administrators responsible for the teacher's performance evaluation shall conduct at least one of the observations
- 4. Other observers who are trained in the evaluation tool may also conduct observations
- 5. The teacher must receive feedback within 30 days after each observation
- 6. Classroom Observations will include the following components:
 - A review of the teacher's lesson plan
 - A review of the state curriculum standard being used in the lesson
 - Pupil engagement in the lesson
 - Evidence collection through the evaluation tool
 - Evaluation conferences will be held both at the beginning of the school year and at the end of the school year and include the required components per training
 - The performance ratings and improvement plans will be consistent with The Thoughtful Classroom Framework, Board of Education Policy and the design of the STAGES software
