Building Health Roadmap Ida Elementary School

Bus

Students will use hand sanitizer when getting on the bus. We encourage students to ride the bus this school year. It is a safe and sure way to make it to school on time. Those not riding the bus will use hand sanitizer when entering the building in the morning.

Mask Mandate for transportation: Masks will be worn while on the bus.

Drop Off/Pick up

Same as last year, please reference the map. Included in the outline are ways to respect the families homes' that are along the route.

- Don't block driveways
- Emergency vehicles might have to get through the line, consider how you would pull over if necessary

Breakfast

Breakfast will be brought to the classrooms on a cart.

Restrooms

Teachers will schedule when they are taking their class to use the restroom, same as last year. The staff like this method since it helps alleviate restroom and hallway congestion.

Cafeteria

Lunch will be held in the multipurpose room. Tables will be called to line up if purchasing lunch.

Recess

There won't be pods on the playground. Kids are free to move about as they would have pre-COVID.

Adult Visitors

High school and Middle school students are welcome in the elementary since the building principals communicate weekly what they are doing to mitigate.

Adults visiting Ida Elementary during instructional time must:

- 1. Schedule an appointment with the teacher or with the office depending on the purpose
- 2. Masks must be worn inside the building. Otherwise, please buzz at the front door and a secretary will come to you.
- 3. Symptom screening will occur

Classroom

Masks are optional. Those who chose to wear a mask won't be any different. The
approach by staff will be the same as any child, each with unique needs and those
needs being respectfully met.

- Students will be encouraged to use their own supplies as much as possible but there will be a return to hands-on and engaging learning. Hand sanitizer will be provided prior to lessons where there will be multiple shared resources.
- If a child is wearing a mask, anyone working with that child for 5 minutes or more, needs to put a mask on, out of respect for the child.

Special Classes

Special classes will return to pre-COVID structures. Each room will be equipped with sanitizer and wipes. Music will be on a cart due to lack of space, not COVID.
