APPLICATION CHECKLIST

TO COMPLETE YOUR CHILD'S APPLICATION, YOU WILL NEED TO BRING THE FOLLOWING:

- ✓ Proof of Income
 - 2022 W-2s
 - Income Tax Return
 - SSI, TANF, SNAP
 - 4 weeks of pay stubs
- ✓ Foster Care documentation if applicable
- ✓ Child's Birth Certificate
- ✓ Immunization Record (if available)
- ✓ Proof of Residency (drivers license, bill, rent lease, etc.)

***SB 133 allows children turning 4 between Sept. 2, 2023 – Dec. 1, 2023 to submit a waiver application. Space is limited based on availability and location. Enrollment may be considered after Sept. 1, 2023.**

is a **tuition-FREE Preschool** that prepares children for kindergarten. Eligible students are children living in Monroe County who attain age 4 by September 1st of the current school year.*

This high-quality preschool program explores the content areas of literacy, math, science, and social studies through active learning experiences. Children develop language and problem solving skills through peer interactions and play. The curriculum is aligned with the Early Childhood Standards of Quality for Pre-kindergarten.

The **Great Start Readiness Program** is funded by a grant from the Michigan Department of Education. The State has identified factors that may affect your child's education at any time in his/her kindergarten through 12th grade school career.
