- ✓ Foster Care documentation (if applicable)
- ✓ Child's Birth Certificate
- ✓ Immunization Record (if available)
- ✓ Proof of Residency (only 1 needed) (drivers license, bill, rent lease, etc.)

*SB 133 allows children turning 4 between Sept. 2, 2025 – Dec. 1, 2025 to submit a waiver application. Space is limited based on availability and location. Enrollment may be considered after August 1, 2025.
