A Free Summer Program to Help You Get Prepared for College

8-week session starts June 17

Monroe County Community College is offering a free 8-week, in-person summer program to help you prepare for college. The program, Bridges to College – Husky Hype-Up, is open to recent high school graduates who are new or current MCCC students and place into developmental courses for Summer or Fall semester.

Seats are limited, and students will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis.

Bridges to College - Husky Hype-Up is focused on supporting learning through reading, writing and math skills and activities to get you ready to become an MCCC Husky and help you build a sense of belonging at Monroe County Community College.

MCCC will provide all of the learning materials and supplies, a free laptop and a \$500 stipend based on attendance and participation, breakfast each day, student engagement activities, resource information, college navigation, access to the college's Heck's Market food pantry.

Bridges to College – Husky Hype-Up will be held at the MCCC Main Campus in Monroe at 1555 S. Raisingville Rd. Sessions are planned for June 17-August 15 with no classes the week of the July 4 holiday. Sessions and most activities are held mostly in the morning, leaving time for summer jobs and activities.
