Google Classroom:

We will be using google classroom as our online platform, make sure you know the following:

Classroom Setup:

Algebra 2: I will post videos/notes/assignments at the beginning of every week for the entire week on google classroom. You will have all week to watch all the videos, take notes, and complete all of the homework. The time face-to-face, in person, will be dedicated to getting extra help. This time will be used for you to ask questions, do practice problems, and strengthen your understanding of the material. Also, we will be taking all of our quizzes/tests in person as well. A students will turn in all of their homework/notes on Monday, B students will turn in all of their homework/notes on Tuesday.

Test Preparation: We will dedicate our time in class, face-to-face, to learning strategies and methods on how to perform well on the SAT. Outside of school, you will be working on Khan Academy/College Board for an assigned amount of time each week. Practice Tests will be taken in class to ensure your learning growth.

Technology for Academics: We will be working in roughly two week intervals. Week one: I will post a project that you will have a week to complete. When you are in class, you are encouraged to ask for help when needed. Week two: This week is dedicated for presenting in class. This cycle then repeats until the end of the semester.

Math Lab: I will assign a weeks worth of daily problems on google classroom at the beginning of each week to be turned in at the beginning of the following week. In class, you are encouraged to ask for help on those problems, but also on any problems you may be having in your math classes.
