- *provide a range of meaningful learning opportunities that meet the needs of all learners

Student:

- *follow teacher instructions on all assignments
- *complete and return all assigned work to the teacher on the due date
- *check Google Classroom daily for new assignments

Parent/Caregiver/Family Responsibilities:

- *review work assigned to the student
- *reserve a space for student to complete work
- *contact teacher if your child is needing additional support
